Equipment

- Tent (if tent camping, cabin space for 10 Females and 20 Males)
- Sleeping bag
- Cot (only if you want, there are 8 cots in each cabin)
- Mess Kit (plate, cup, and table wear) – We will be eating multiple meals so paper products are not recommended.
- Pillow
- Blanket / Sheet

Clothing / Personal Supplies

- Change of clothes for 3 days
- Rain Gear (if forecast is calling for rain)
- Boots / Shoes that can get dirty (we will be in the outdoors / woods)
- Toiletries
 - Toothbrush & Toothpaste
 - Washing Rag
 - Personal Care Items
 - Medications

We will be camping at Camp Manatoc, located in Peninsula, Ohio. We have reserved 3 cabins each with 8 bunks in each. There is room for several other cots in each cabin, as well as space for tents at our campsite. We will have one cabin for women/girls and the other two will be assigned to men/boys. The men/boys cabin spaces will be assigned from youngest to oldest (Tigers first, then Wolves, Bears, Webelos, Arrows). There are no flush toilets or showers, only latrines and water faucets. If you are participating in the Haunted Hayride we are less than ½ a mile from Camp Butler and are planning to walk there from the campsite. Call or email Mr. Grove if you have any questions.
